Where does the money go?

2021 Sleepout funds will support all our ministries serving our local community as follows: 50% for the Bridge's general fund, 25% for Kids at Risk, and 25% for the *Valley Food Pantry*.

The Bridge serves the school districts of Sayre, Athens, & Waverly. The Bridge's ability to serve was greatly effected by COVID-19. Processes needed to be modified. In 2020, the money entrusted to us was used to:

- Assist 163 adults and 97 children with vouchers totaling just over \$40,000, mostly for housing related needs, including rent, security deposits, heat, electric, and water.
- Provide a total of over 8,459 items of clothing, small household items, books and toys free of charge through 444 households through the ministry of *The Clothes Closet*.
- Assist 89 households with furniture and household items free of charge through our *Helping Hands* ministry.
- Assist approximately 641 students with hygiene supplies, clothing, and/or school supplies through our *Kids at Risk* ministry.
- Provide food items to 579 households in NY and PA through the ministry of the *Valley Food Pantry*. Provided food to 175-200 households, Jan, Mar, Aug, and Oct –Dec with the *Mobile Food Pantry*.

Where does the money go?

2019 Sleepout funds will support all our ministries serving our local community as follows: 50% for the Bridge's general fund, 25% for Kids at Risk, and 25% for the *Valley Food Pantry*.

The Bridge serves the school districts of Sayre, Athens, & Waverly. In 2018, the money entrusted to us was used to:

- Assist 396 adults and 271 children with vouchers totaling just over \$73,000, mostly for housing related needs, including rent, security deposits, heat, electric, and water.
- Provide a total of over 32,127 items of clothing, small household items, books and toys free of charge through 2,007 contacts through the ministry of *The Clothes Closet*.
- Assist 132 households with furniture and household items free of charge through our *Helping Hands* ministry.
- Assist approximately 951 students with hygiene supplies, clothing, and/or school supplies through our *Kids at Risk* ministry.
- Provide food items to 1,413 households in NY and PA through the ministry of the *Valley Food Pantry* and 35,523 meals to 1,605 households through the once a month *Mobile Food Pantry*.
- Provide help to 6 households through our *Interim and Catastrophic Assistance Programs,*




